**R. Gauthier:** Patricia is very creative and an excellent writer.

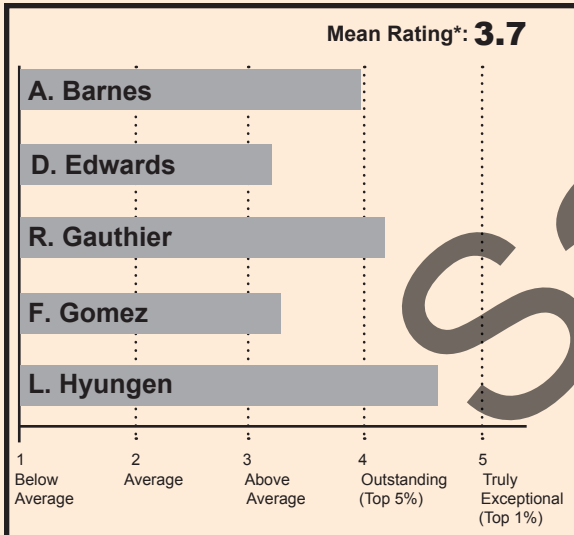
**F. Gomez:** Patricia consistently came up with novel and interesting ideas in our staff meetings.

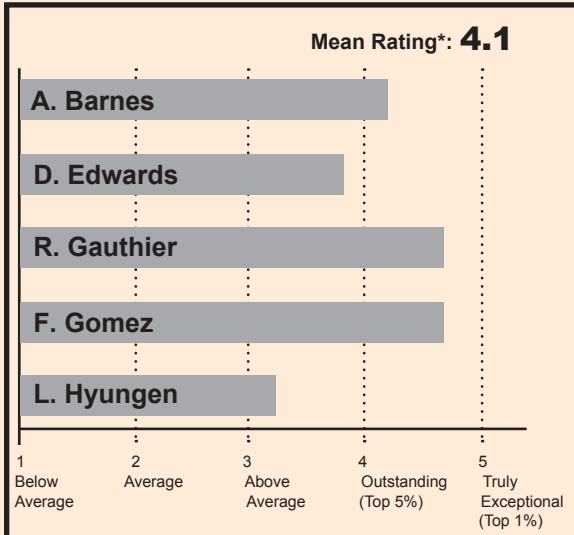

**R. Gauthier:** I emphasize collaboration and teamwork in my classes and Patricia shines in this area.

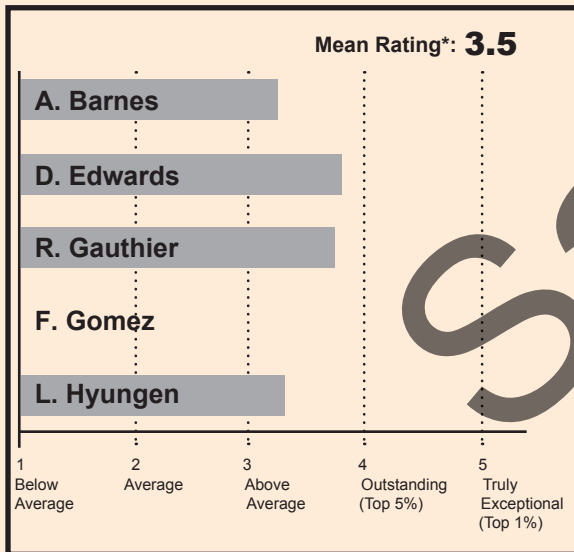
**F. Gomez:** Patricia works well with the other people at the company.

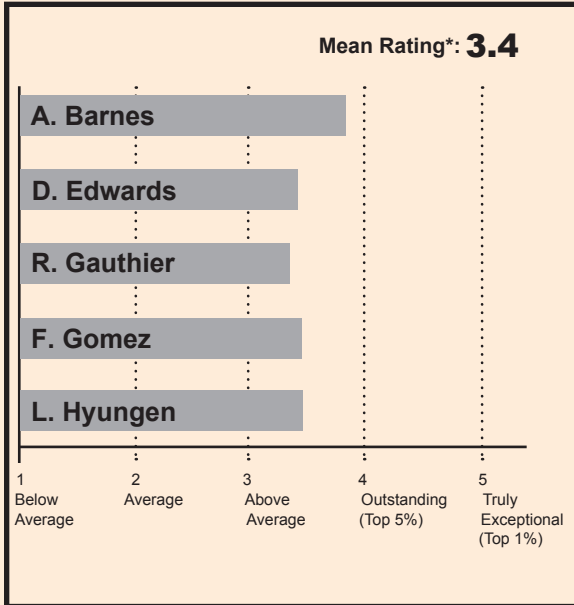

**R. Gauthier:** Very organized, well-prepared.

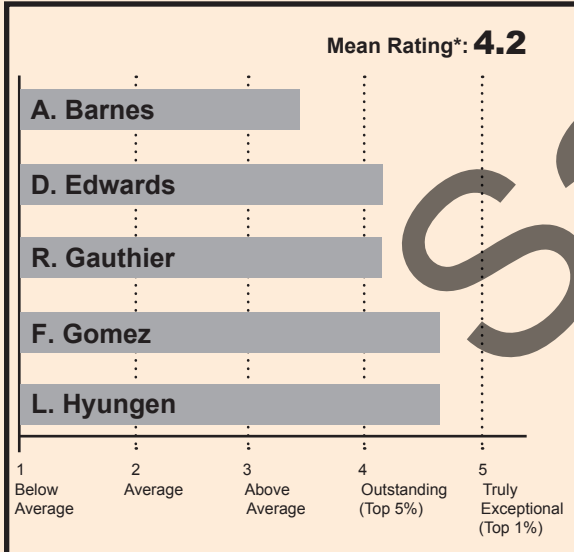
**F. Gomez:** Patricia organizes her time well. She does an impressive job of managing the competing demands of working half-time while going to school full-time.

**L. Hyungen:** Patricia maintains the highest ethical standards.

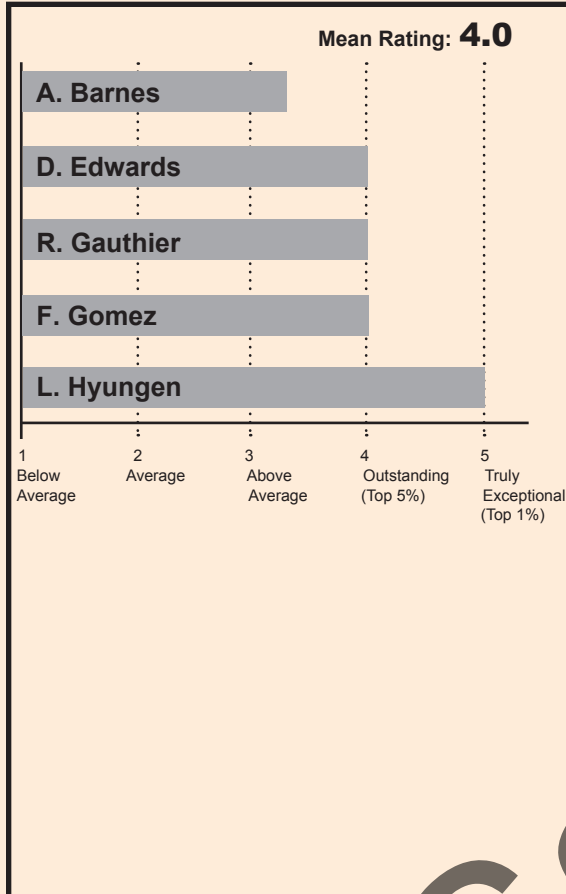
