Disclaimer about data sorted by Attending Institution:

Examinees are not required to identify the institution they are attending. As a consequence, only about 56% of examinees in 2010-11, 59% in 2009-10, and 70% in 2008-09 have identified an undergraduate institution, and the data from these self-selected examinees is self-reported. Furthermore, some of these examinees have been out of school for several years. Even more importantly, the GRE General Test has not been designed to measure state level education outcomes. For all of these reasons, caution should be exercised in seeing these results as an accurate reflection on the current undergraduate curriculum.
