Topic: Secondary School Technical Assistance

Goal: To improve student achievement at the secondary level statewide.

Project Description: This year, our efforts will focus on leveraging resources to assist the FLDOE in developing their support for under-performing districts and schools and improving high school achievement across the state. The SSTA team (FLICC and FLDOE’s Bureau of School Improvement) will work with the new regional assistance centers personnel and the Southern Regional Education Board (SREB) to improve learning at the secondary school and district level.

Project Objectives:

- 1. Assist the FLDOE’s Bureau of School Improvement in building district capacity to support under-performing secondary schools through the High Schools That Work and CROP Initiatives**
- 2. Assist the FLDOE in building student achievement in high schools by building their capacity to uniformly implement high school majors (the FLDOE’s Major Area of Interest program)**
