# Expectations of the Task Force

## Expectations (cont'd)

- Develop a VIDE SIP Operational Manual that addresses those key components and processes
- Identify clear roles and responsibilities for the SEA, LEA and schools in the SIP process

- Develop/adopt a standardized SIP template to be used by all USVI districts and schools
- Align the SIP process with the State Priorities
- Develop a plan to roll out the new VIDE SIP Operational Manual to districts and schools
