



Updates to the *Praxis*® Core Mathematics Test — Test Taker FAQs

Q: What is changing?

A: In September 2019, the content of the *Praxis*® Core Mathematics test will change.

Q: Which *Praxis* Core Mathematics test am I required to take?

A: Until August 2020, there will be two *Praxis* Core Mathematics tests, which are distinguished by test codes 5732 (current) and 5733 (new). It is important for you to visit the [state requirements page](#) to find out which test you must take.

Q: What should I do if I registered for the wrong test?

A: To cancel your test, visit our [registration page](#).

Q: What changes are on the new *Praxis* Core Mathematics test?

A: The new test has an increased emphasis on data interpretation and representation, statistics and probability. There is a reduced emphasis on algebra and geometry. To find out what is covered on your test, review the test specifications in Chapter 1 of the corresponding Study Companion: [Core Mathematics \(5732\)](#) and [Core Mathematics \(5733\)](#) tests.

Q: Did the Core Academic Skills for Educators: Reading and Core Academic Skills for Educators: Writing tests change?

A: No, the content of the tests has not changed. However, until August 2020, there will be two versions of each test. The only difference between them is the test code: 5712 (current) and 5713 (new) for Core Reading and 5722 (current) and 5723 (new) for Core Writing.

Q: When will updated test prep be available for the new *Praxis* Core Mathematics test?

A: All aligned test prep will be available on July 22, the first day you can register for the tests.

Q: If my state has not migrated to the new *Praxis* Core tests, can test prep help me?
