### What are the Praxis® assessments?

The *Praxis*® tests measure teacher candidates' knowledge and skills. The tests are used for licensing and certification purposes.

### Who takes the Praxis assessments and why?

The *Praxis* assessments are taken by individuals seeking admission to an educator preparation program and/or seeking educator certification in states throughout the United States. You should check [www.ets.org/praxis/states](http://www.ets.org/praxis/states) or your state Department of Education website to determine *Praxis* test requirements in the state where you want to teach.

### How do I register?

You can register for a *Praxis* test (after confirming your state's eligibility and testing requirements) in any of these ways: online, by phone, or by U.S. mail. To register online, go to <https://www.ets.org/portal/site/iserpraxis/menuitem.1b7fdbe6788d618e6c41265a7beb1509>. To register by phone, call 1-800-772-9476, Monday–Friday, 8 a.m. to 7:45 p.m. ET and pay by credit/debit card. To register by U.S. mail, complete the Test Authorization Voucher Request Form (PDF) at [https://www.ets.org/s/praxis/pdf/cdt\\_authorization\\_voucher\\_request.pdf](https://www.ets.org/s/praxis/pdf/cdt_authorization_voucher_request.pdf) and mail it to ETS. Once your request is processed, a voucher number will be sent to you, along with instructions on completing your registration. Allow three weeks for delivery of the voucher.

### Can I take a Praxis test outside the U.S.?

You can take a *Praxis* test outside the U.S. only if you are taking the test for employment, certification or entrance into a teacher education program *in the United States*. For most *Praxis* tests, testing is done at a Prometric® center. For World Language tests (Chinese Mandarin, French, German, and Spanish), testing is done at Prometric centers and various other sites. To register, go to your *Praxis* account. ### How are Praxis tests administered?

All *Praxis* tests are taken on computer, except for the Braille Proficiency test.

### What if I need disability accommodations?

- ▶ To request accommodations, you must submit your request, and have it approved by ETS Disability Services before you can register and schedule your test.

### What should I know about ID requirements?

It is important to know the identification requirements *before* you take the test. ID requirements are strictly enforced. Valid and acceptable ID with your **name**, **signature**, and **photograph** is required for admission to a test. Your complete name and signature as shown on your ID must match EXACTLY the name you registered. ### What security measures are taken at test centers?

ID verification at registration or at the test center may include biometric voice and photo ID, fingerprinting or thumbprinting, video surveillance, and signature comparison. At some centers, electronic scanning devices have also been implemented. These measures supplement the requirement that you present valid and acceptable ID documents. Failure to comply with these security measures may result in dismissal from the test and forfeiture of your test fees.

### How do I change or cancel a test registration?

To change the test date, test time, or testing center for your test or to cancel a test that you have already registered for, log in to your *Praxis* account and process the change or call ETS at 1-800-772-9476. Changes or cancellations must be made **at least three days before your test date, not including the day of the test**.

### Where can I find test preparation materials?

Free test preparation materials are available on the *Praxis* website at [www.ets.org/praxis/prepare/materials/](http://www.ets.org/praxis/prepare/materials/). Interactive practice tests can be purchased in the ETS Store at <http://www.ets.org/store/praxis>.

### When will my scores be available?

Scores for the *Praxis* Core Reading and Mathematics tests are available 21 **calendar** days after the day of the test. Scores for the *Praxis* Core Writing test are available 21 **business** days after the test day. Scores for all other selected-response tests that are given continuously are available 7 calendar days after the day of the test. Scores for constructed-response tests that are given continuously are available 21 calendar days after the day of the test. Scores for tests taken in fixed windows are available 2-3 weeks after the testing window closes, regardless of the date you took the test during that window.
