Get started

Determine which *Praxis* tests you'll need to take and where you can take them. Each state sets its own testing requirements, so be sure to check for each state you plan to become certified in at www.ets.org/praxis/states.

Register

- search for a test center by ZIP code or state for the test location closest to you
- check seat availability in real time
- select your four free score recipients prior to test day
